

Hospitality Obligation Policy

It is the policy of ISE Ontario that ISE Ontario families understand their obligation to follow through with the reciprocal nature of an exchange. Lack of reciprocity may result in additional fees being charged in order to find new accommodations for your original partner.

Procedures:

1. As part of the Conditions of Participation, parents will be advised that they are committing to the reciprocal nature of the exchange program.
2. By signing this document, families will be obliged to host a student after their son or daughter has completed the first phase of an exchange as a 'Go First' participant.
3. Families that refuse to host the original partner of their son or daughter will be expected to host another student from the country where the exchange was arranged. Should a family not host a child and fulfill in completion the reciprocity expectation, additional fees may apply as payment towards an alternate 'host-only' family.
4. In 'Host First' situations, a family that does not complete the hosting period but still wants their son or daughter to be placed in a different home in Europe, will be expected to host another European student.
5. School board authorities must be advised of the 'one in, one out' status of these situations and ISE Ontario is obliged to recognize the balance and see that it is maintained in terms of placing students in a board.
